



Decision Grid for COVID-19 Response for Students/Staff

| Scenario | Response |
|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Student/Staff has COVID-19 symptoms <u>OR</u> a fever ≥ 100.4 | A. Student/Staff received a negative COVID-19 test <u>AND</u> they receive a definitive alternate diagnosis from a physician (e.g. ear infection, strep throat, RSV) and has been fever free for 72 hours without taking fever-reducing meds. Student/Staff may return to school with a copy of the negative test. |
| | B. Student/Staff is not tested for COVID-19 <u>AND</u> does not have a definitive alternative diagnosis from a physician they must quarantine for 10 days. |
| Student/Staff test positive for COVID-19 with symptoms | C. Student/Staff should quarantine for 10 days from date symptoms began. |
| Student/Staff test positive for COVID-19 with no symptoms | D. Student/Staff should quarantine until 10 days after the TEST date. |
| Student/Staff has been exposed to COVID and they are NOT fully vaccinated | E. Student/Staff should quarantine for 10 days regardless of whether or not they have symptoms. |
| Student/Staff has been exposed to COVID and they ARE fully vaccinated. | F. Student/Staff does not have to quarantine if they were masked at the time of the exposure and do not have symptoms (Kentucky Public Health recommends that you get tested 3-5 days after the exposure). |

If you develop any of these symptoms, get tested:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
